

Size Charts for Products Module for PrestaShop

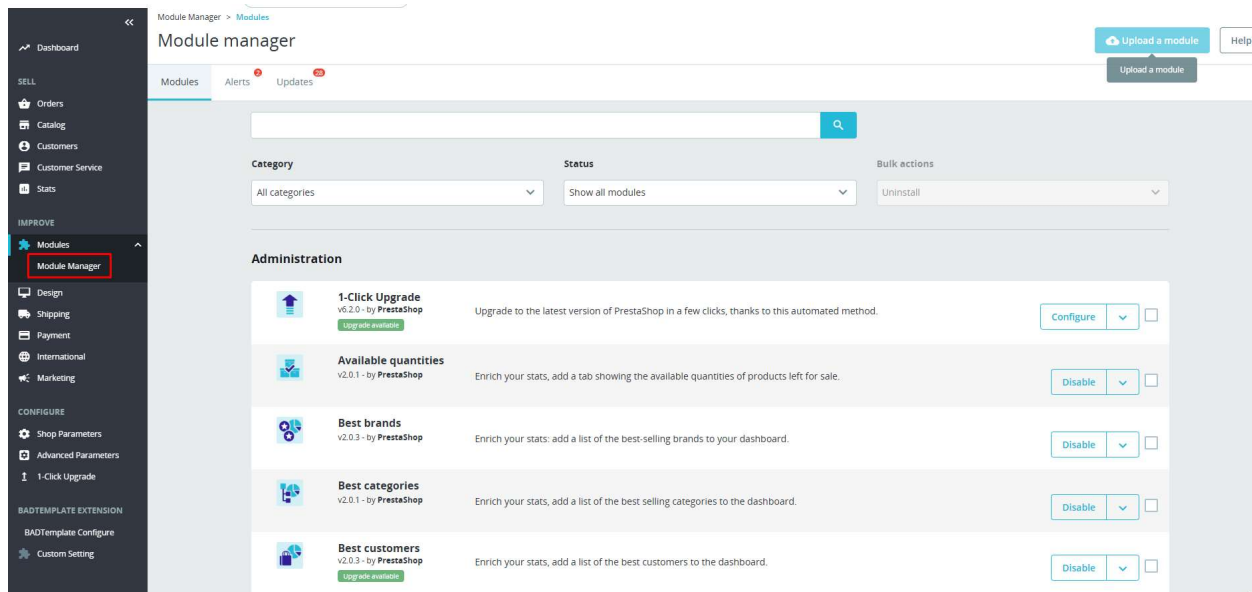
The Size Charts for Products Module for PrestaShop allows you to provide your customers with detailed size information for your products, enhancing their shopping experience and reducing the likelihood of returns. This module enables you to create and manage customizable size charts that can be easily integrated into your product pages, helping customers make informed purchasing decisions.

Module installation

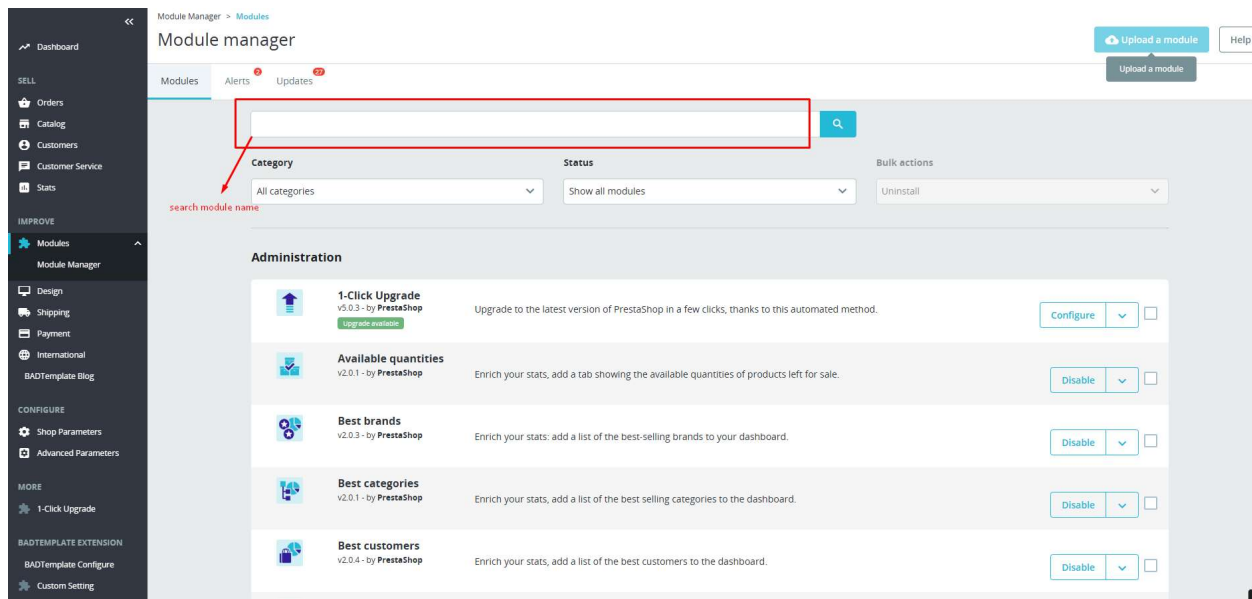
Follow these methods:

1. Using File Structure

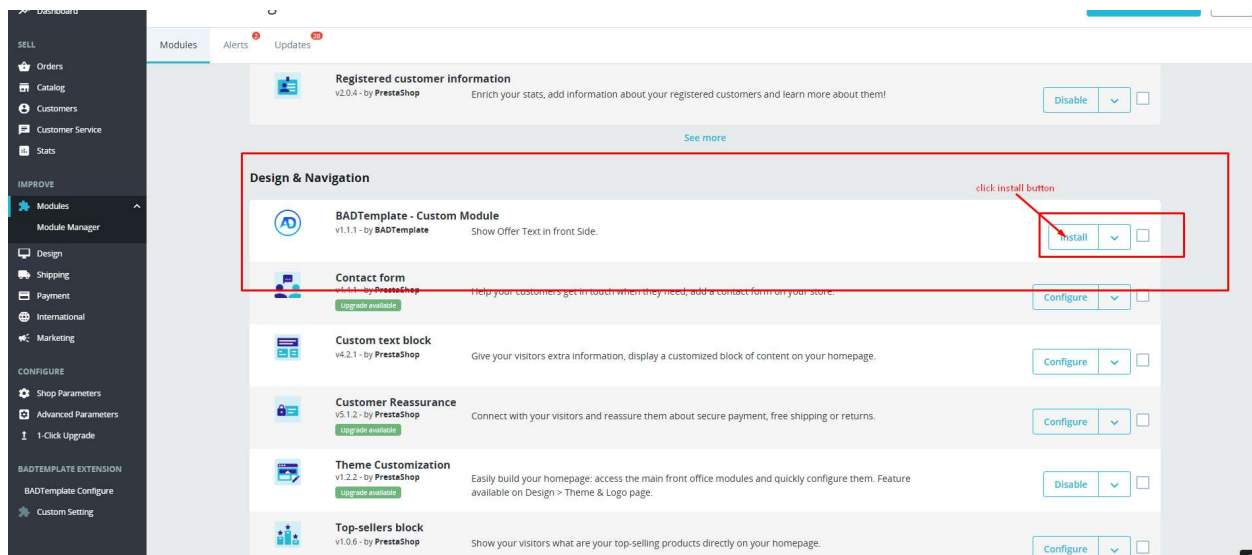
- 01.** Unzip (decompress) the module archive file
- 02.** Using your FTP software
- 03.** Place the folder in your PrestaShop /modules folder
- 04.** Connect to the BackOffice of your shop
- 05.** Go to Back Office >> Modules.



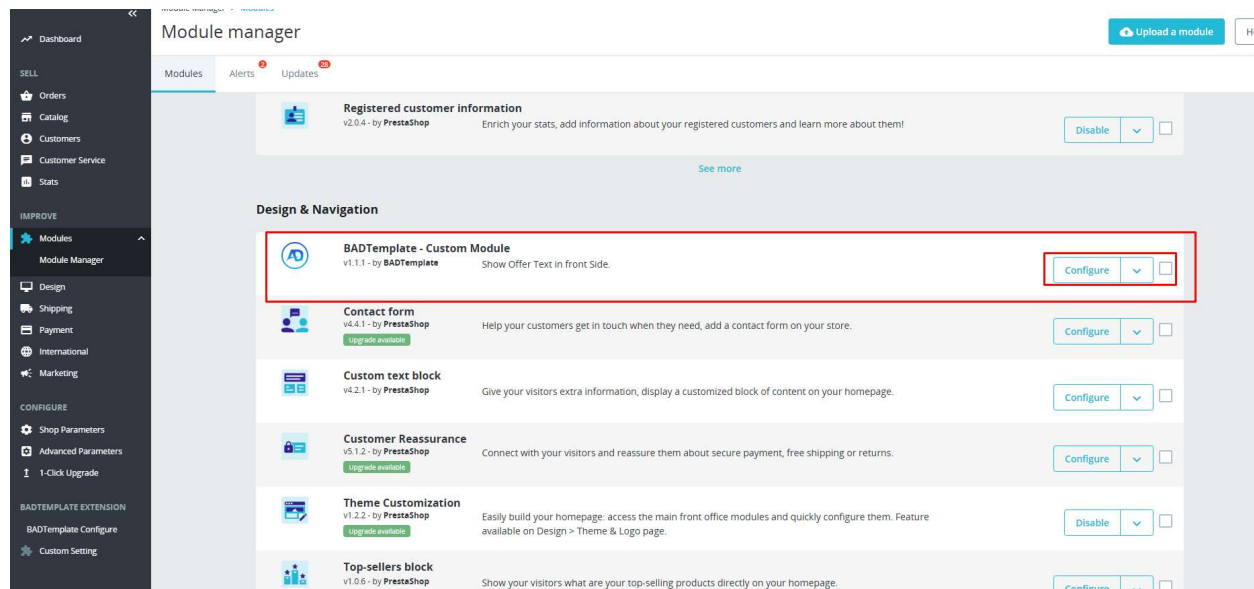
06. Locate the new module in the list, scrolling down if necessary.



07. In the row for the new module, click Install.



08. Locate the module again. If necessary, click >> Configure.

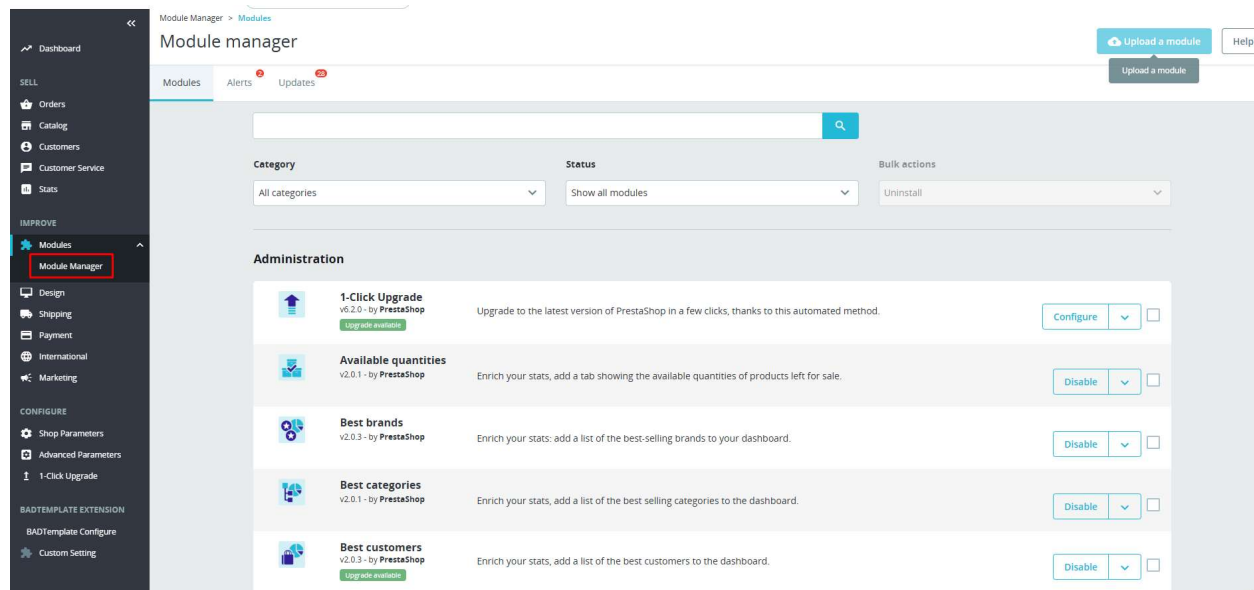


09. Once configuration is complete, be sure to test the module immediately to confirm that it functions as planned.

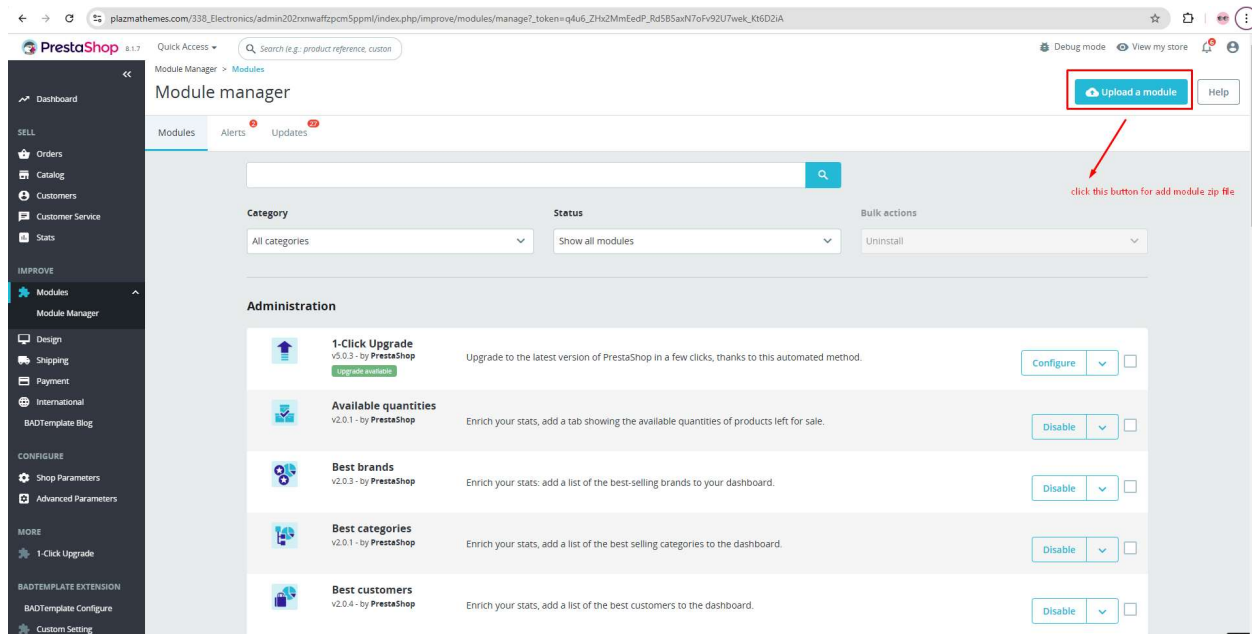
2. Using Back Office

01. Connect to the BackOffice of your shop

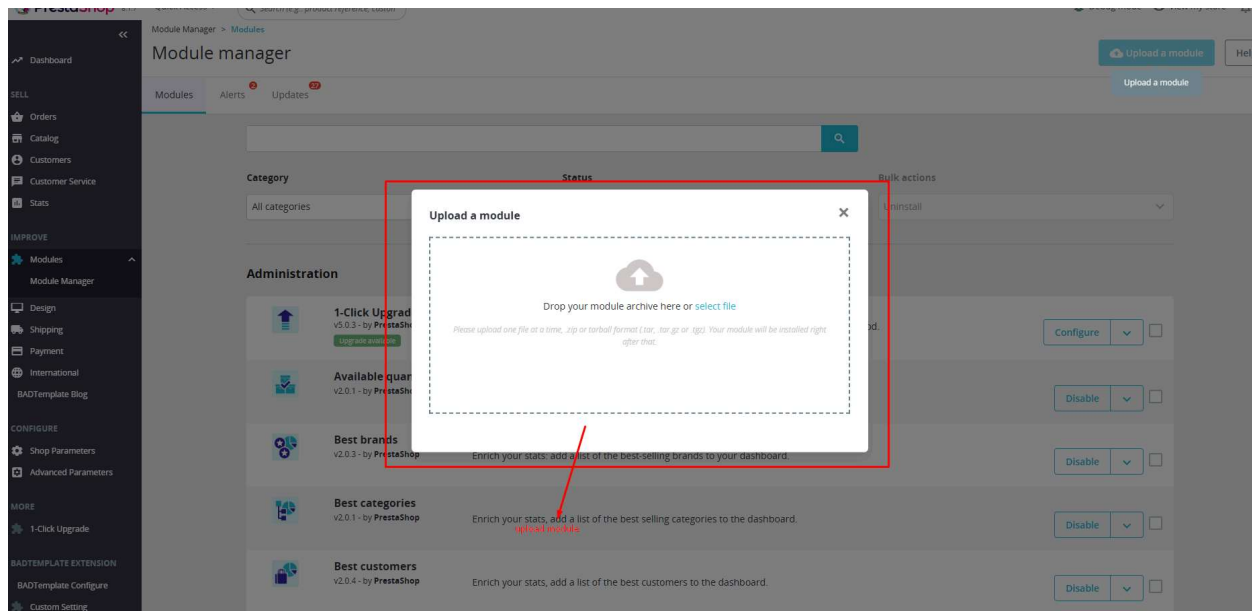
02. Go to Back Office >> Modules.



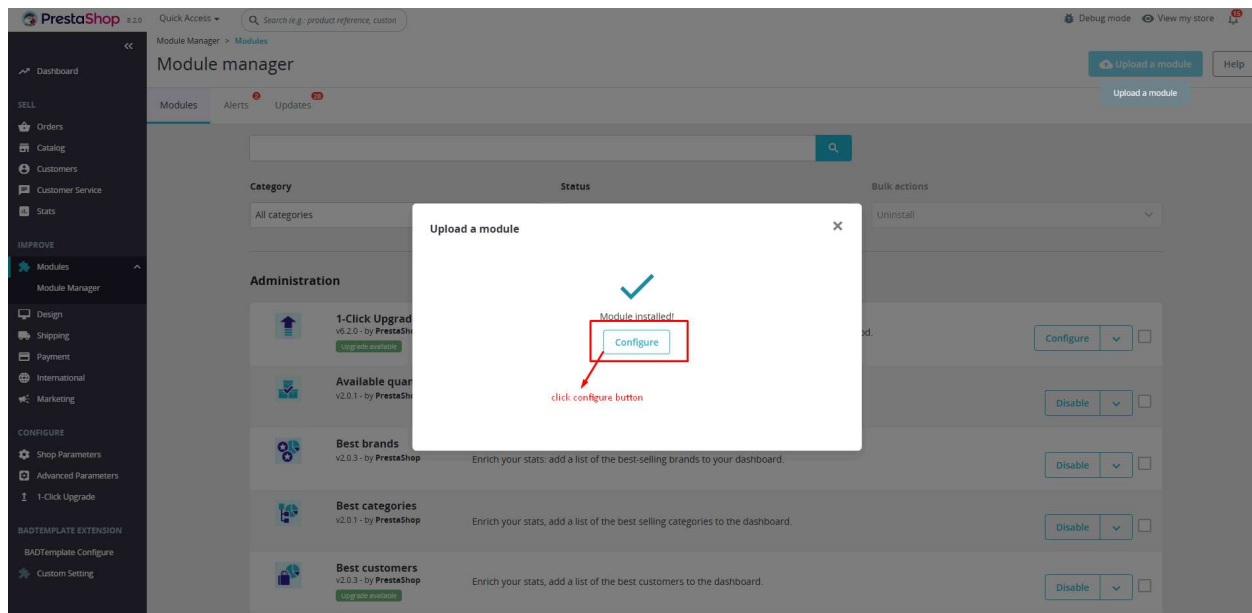
03. Click Upload Module Button



04. Add Module Zip File



05. Click Module Configure Button



06. Once configuration is complete, be sure to test the module immediately to confirm that it functions as planned

Select Your Attribute

1. Enabled

If set to "Yes," the size chart will be displayed where applicable. If "No," the size chart will be disabled.

2. Title

Input Field: Enter the title of the size chart. This is typically displayed on the front end above the size chart.

Example: "Size Chart for Women's Apparel."

3. Assign to Categories

Checkbox List: Select the categories where this size chart should be applied.

Example: If you select "Home," the size chart will only appear for products assigned to the "Home" category.

4. Assign to Brands

Selection Box: Choose the specific brands to which this size chart applies.

If a product belongs to both the selected category and brand, the size chart will be displayed on the product page.

5. Description

Rich Text Editor: Add the content of the size chart in a table or paragraph format. You can use the editor to format text, add rows/columns, or customize the layout.

The visible example shows a table with headings (th0, th1, etc.) and corresponding cells (cell0,0, cell0,1, etc.).

Use the editor tools to modify font style, add links, or insert images.

6. Table Generator

Rows/Columns Input Fields: Specify the number of rows and columns you need for your table.

Header Row: Check this box if you want the first row to serve as a heading for the columns.

Bordered: Adds borders around the table cells.

Striped: Applies a striped style for alternate rows, improving readability.

Generate Table Button: Automatically creates a table in the description field based on the specified rows and columns.

7. Save or Submit

At the bottom (not shown fully in the image), there is likely a "Save" or "Submit" button to save the configuration and apply the size chart.
